The Junior Section is part of the CIO with management responsibility from Jane Waterhouse as Trustee/Junior Chair and Charlotte Burns as Junior Secretary who attend the monthly Main Management Committee.

We continue to have a very effective Junior Committee with some excellent volunteers. We are always keen to get more support and if you can help out then please get in touch! Kit

All players MUST wear gum shields and we advise using shin pads for training and matches. Other protective wear such as headgear and shoulder padding is not essential and is down to the discretion of the player's parent/carer. However, they MUST carry the IRB approval label. Hot showers are always available, therefore a towel and a change of clothes for the Club House are recommended.

Training, Playing and Registration

WEDNESDAY evenings from 6.30pm to 7.30pm for Under 7s to Under 13s and 7.30pm to 8.30pm for Under 14s to Under 16s.

Games arranged for **SUNDAYS** for up to Under 16s.

Our **Colts** train on Senior Training nights which are Tuesdays and Thursdays.

ALL PLAYERS <u>must</u> play in their <u>right age group</u> (i.e. their School Year, e.g. Under 11s is School Year 6), if unsure speak to the coach. This remains RFU Regulation for the 2017/18 Season.

There is normally a Tuck Shop open and bacon batches and hot dogs are for sale. We encourage all players to buy their OCs Junior shirt, shorts and socks.

All players **must** complete a Player Registration Form, which is for the safety and welfare of the player. It is important that the club is informed of emergency contact numbers and any medical condition or allergies that may be relevant should the player fall ill or be involved in an accident/injury while at the club or an away game.

All new players **must** also complete an RFU Registration Form and provide 2 passport sized photos for an RFU card. The is no additional cost for this and scanned photos will do. If you have a card already, you don't need to replace it each year!

We also need to ensure that all our young players are not involved in playing too much rugby, so please keep the coach informed on any other rugby played other than at OCs.


Player Safeguards

Information is available on the Notice board and on the OCs Website. We suggest you


read them, together we can set good standards and fair play for all involved. This applies to
